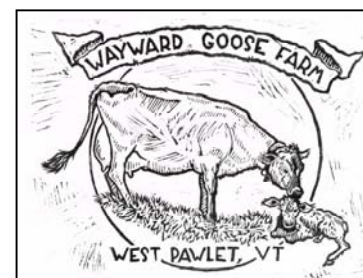


GRAZING SCHOOL at Consider Bardwell & Wayward Goose Farms
