No-Till modifications will be highlighted, including retrofits for older planters. Examples of no-till planter modifications including closing wheels, row cleaners, and fertilizer application options will be discussed in depth. Planters will be at each site (John Deere in Colchester; Kinze and White in Weybridge) to talk about all the add-ons, and what is really necessary to plant no-till.
