Entry deadline: Monday August 5th, 2024

All products must entered between 8am-12pm

Bring entries to the Jeff Carter Crop Exhibit (north end of the 4-H Exhibit Building)

Classes-Field Crops, Forage & Grain

Limit one entry per class for each form

Whole Plants

1. Corn Plants - 3 whole plants with roots
2. Soybeans - 10 plants with roots
3. Cereal Grains - 20 stems (wheat, barley, oat, rye)

Silage Crops

4. Corn Silage - 1 quart jar
5. Corn Snaplage – 1 quart jar
6. Ground Ear Corn - 1 quart jar
7. Grass Haylage - 1 quart jar
8. Legume Haylage (alfalfa, clover) - 1 quart jar
9. Baled/Wrapped Silage Hay – 1 quart jar
10. Cereal Grain Silage – 1 quart jar

Dry Hay

11. 1st Cut Legume Hay (alfalfa, clover)- 1 slice of bale
12. 1st Cut Grass Hay - 1 slice of bale
13. 2nd Cut Legume Hay (alfalfa, clover)- 1 slice of bale
14. 2nd Cut Grass Hay - 1 slice of bale

Grain Crops

15. Corn Grain Whole Kernel - 1 quart jar
16. Corn Grain Ground - 1 quart jar
17. Soybean Grain - 1 quart jar
18. Cereal Grain (wheat, barley, oat, rye) - 1 quart jar
19. Other Dry Grain (oilseed, buckwheat, other) - 1 quart jar

Samples will be judged on:

- Freedom from plant defects or contamination
- Yield and crop quality potential
- Proper maturity at harvest for storage
- Proper moisture content for stage
- Conformation of size and uniformity
