Individualized education for the experienced farm business manager.

UVM Extension offers Ag Biz Pro to support business solutions for your commercial farm. Participating farm managers will work directly with a farm business adviser within a flexible curriculum to address priority issues facing the business. This may include the preparation of updated financial statements, cost analysis or strategic analysis developed from current farm records. Farmers complete the annual program by synthesizing the analysis with the adviser and identifying key business strategies for the coming year. This course features at least 2 on-farm visits per year.

Ag Biz Pro is the program of choice for farm managers who wish to continue working with an individual adviser after completing a grant funded Farm Viability business planning project.
