## Seeking farmers for interviews

A new research study at the University of Vermont is recruiting farmers to express their perspectives on regulations that affect agriculture. The project aims to assess the diversity of regulations, their reporting requirements, time and financial resources required to comply, and whether this impacts farms and communities. Interviews with farmers are being scheduled for November 2017-January 2018. Farmers will be compensated a \$50 gift card. Results will be reported to state and federal policymakers as well as be presented at a forum held at UVM in spring 2018. This project is funded by the Jeffords Center for Policy Research at UVM.
