


Fully Online Certificate of Graduate Study (CGS) in Resiliency-based Approaches with families schools and communities

Description: This innovative Certificate of Graduate Study coursework will provide students an opportunity to enhance their understanding of how to build resilience and respond to trauma and adversity using appreciative, strength-based, restorative, and interprofessional partnership-oriented approaches. Through graduate coursework, students will (a) gain a deeper socio-ecological understanding of the structural solutions inherent in equity, culturally sustaining partnerships, and resilience, (b) learn about the impact of trauma and adversity including racial and cultural healing, and (c) build a toolbox of skills for fostering resilience through trusting partnerships with families, schools, and communities.
